

## **Consumer Information on Tax Credits for Air Sealing and Insulation Materials Costs**

This information is being provided for customers to use as needed or desired to claim a 25C tax credit that is consistent with the current requirements from IRS with a final determination by your professional tax advisor. **This is not a legal document-just information for contractor and tax advisor.**

The 25C Tax Credit allows for a 30% credit up to \$1200 for the cumulation of eligible energy efficiency products purchased by the homeowner for their residence. This tax credit includes for air sealing or insulation materials which are only a portion of the cost of the measures. The consumer needs to know the cost, for the materials used in the installation and these are noted below by your contractor.

**customer information:** If you receive an incentive to lower the overall cost of the air sealing and weatherization measures, only the remaining balance that you are paying would be available to be used to be claimed for the tax credit. In some cases the measure cost may exceed your customer cost but in most states this would not be true. In addition, if there are other measures or products that you are purchasing/installing that can apply for 25C tax credits, the \$1,200 cap would apply to all measures/products.

This information should be provided to your accountant along with your receipt for tax filing and saved with your records. .
